

Our staff have been busy preparing for students' return. We are so excited to have them back! Here are a few instructions for arrival and dismissal on Tuesday, September 8th:

GRADE 1-5 STUDENTS

8:05 - 8:30 a.m. BUS STUDENTS ARRIVE

Staff will be at the front of the school to greet students and show them to their designated entry door. A staff member will be at each entry door to assist students with sanitizing hands and, for grades 4 and up, putting on a mask. We have cloth masks available or students may choose to bring their own mask from home to wear.

8:38-8:45 a.m. DROP-OFF/WALKING STUDENTS ARRIVE

Staff will be at the front of the school to greet students and show them to their designated entry door. A staff member will be at each entry door to assist students with sanitizing hands and, for grades 4 and up, putting on a mask. We have cloth masks available or students may choose to bring their own mask from home to wear. If you would like to wait outside with your child, please maintain a safe distance from other families.

Students will be greeted by teachers as they enter the school and our first day will begin.

3:03 p.m. DISMISSAL TIME FOR DROP-OFF/WALKING STUDENTS

The first dismissal bell will be at 3:03 p.m. Students will exit from their designated doors and immediately leave the school grounds. Staff will be outside to assist students. If you are picking up your child, you can wait for them outside near their exit door or in the parking lot. Please maintain a safe distance from other parents while you are waiting.

3:13 p.m. DISMISSAL TIME FOR BUS STUDENTS

The second dismissal bell will be at 3:13 p.m. Students will exit from their designated doors and immediately go to their bus line at the front of the school. Staff will be outside to assist students to get to their line-up and to get on their bus. You can make our job easier by attaching a large tag on the outside of your child's backpack with their bus number printed on it.

KINDERGARTEN AND JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN

A reminder that Kindergarten and Junior Kindergarten students do not come to school on September 8 or 9. Kindergarten and Junior Kindergarten parents who have made appointments with the teacher will enter/exit through the front door. Ring the doorbell to the right of the door. Please do not arrive before your scheduled time. Before entering

the school, complete the Covid-19 Alberta Health Daily Checklist, sanitize your hands and put on a mask.

For safety reasons, all adults must book an appointment before they will be able to enter the school. Appointments can be booked by calling 780-723-3397.
