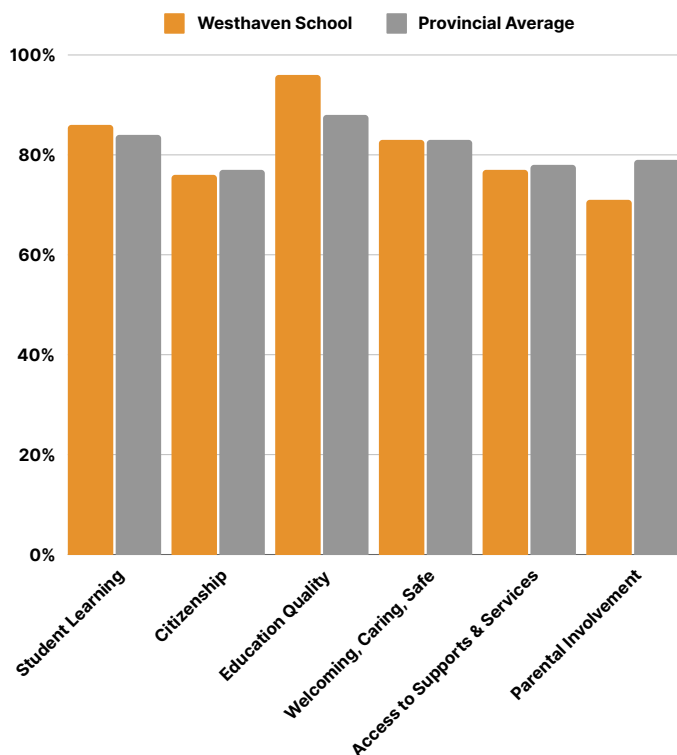


Westhaven Elementary School School Continous Improvement Plan 2024-25



THREE-YEAR VISION

Westhaven School continues to have good results on the Alberta Assurance Measure Survey. On the Spring 2024 survey, we ranked similar to the provincial average in most areas. We surpassed the provincial average by 9% in the *Education Quality* area. The one area we'll be monitoring is *Parental Involvement*, which was flagged as a possible issue but also had a low number of respondents.



Westhaven is working on the second year of our three-year vision: 100% of students will read at or above grade level before the end of grade 5.

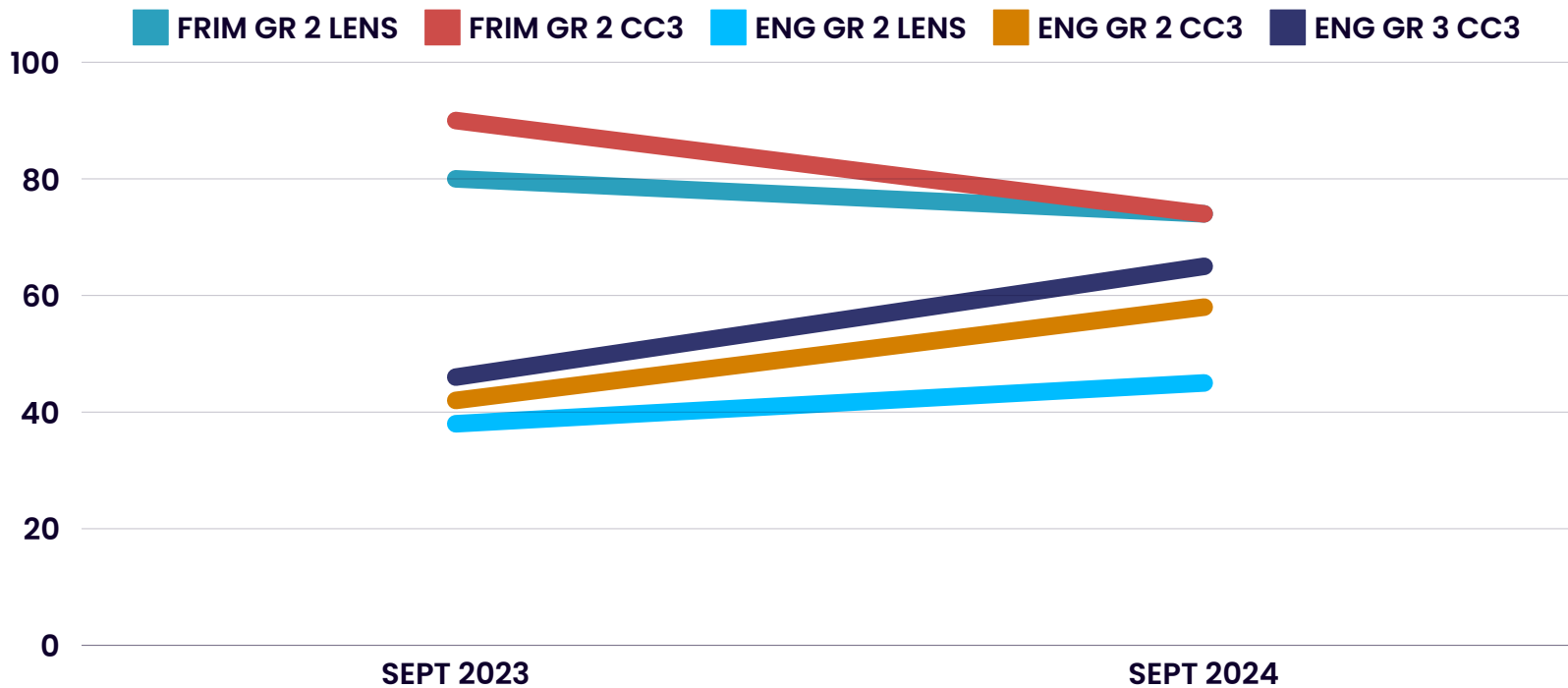


Progress toward the 100% Vision is measured through AB Education - Early Years Literacy Assessment results and F&P, GB+ Reading Assessment results.

■ FRIM Grade 2

Grade 2 French Immersion results dropped from 80%-90% not requiring supports down to 74% of FRIM students not requiring additional supports

■ FRIM Grade 3

Grade 3 French Immersion results are not shown on this graph due to an error in the data entry process

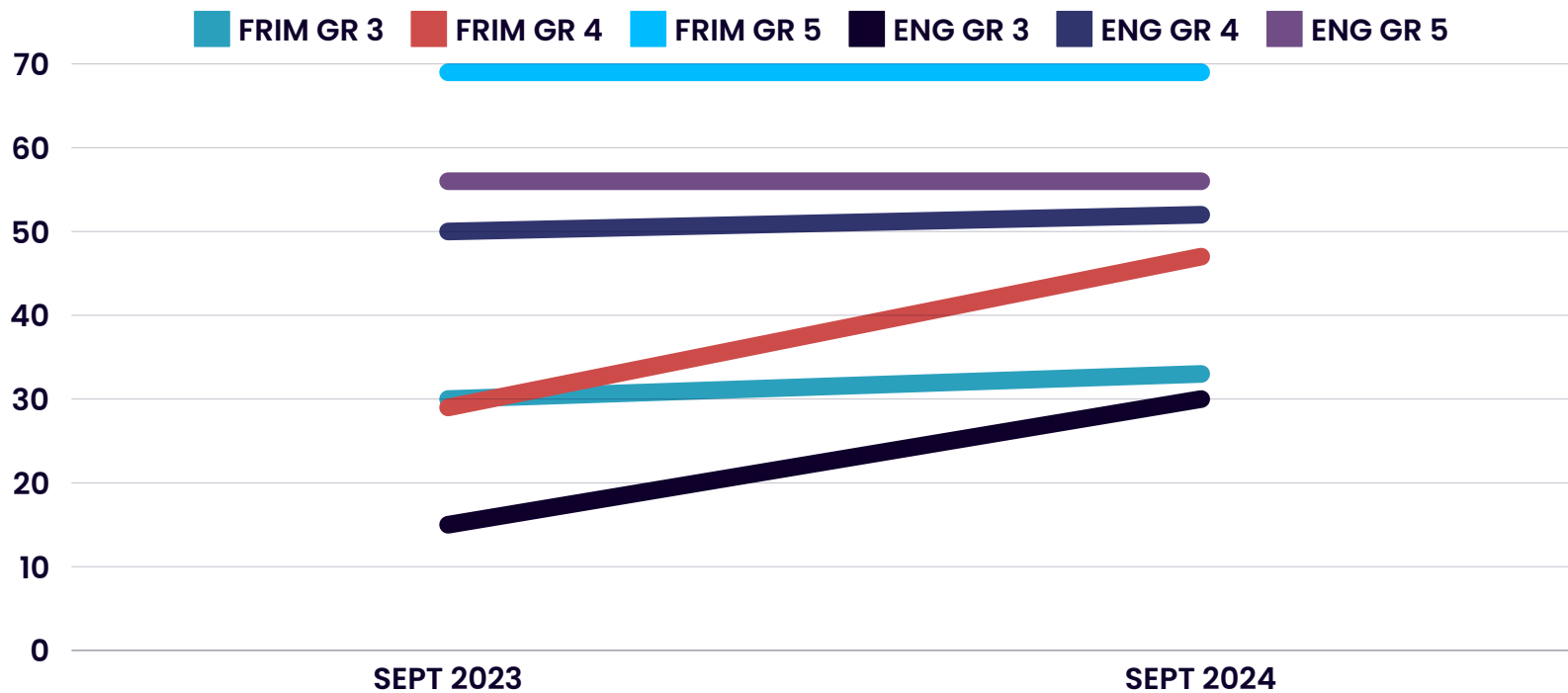
■ ENG Grade 2&3

All 2024 assessments for Grade 2 and 3 students show less students requiring supports. The trend shows that our 90-day plans in Year One have been helping to support student progress.

SAME COHORT, RESULTS COMPARISON 2023 TO 2024

STUDENTS AT OR ABOVE GRADE LEVEL



■ Grades 3 & 4

The grade 3 & 4 cohorts have all shown improvement in the percentage of students reading at or above grade level.

■ Grade 3 ENG

The grade 3 English cohort has shown the most growth out off all our groups with the percentage of students at or above grade level increasing from 15% to 33%.

■ Grade 5

Grade 5 (English and FRIM) cohort results from Sept. 2023 to Sept. 2024 show that the percentage of students reading at or above grade level has stayed the same.

Sharing RESULTS & Setting GOALS

On-going

Staff continue to review and refine the 90-day plan(s) based on achievement data to close learning gaps and ensure every student succeeds.

Staff Aug. 2024

Staff identified school-wide learning gaps in literacy. Areas of focus to help close the learning gaps and to move us closer to our 100% Vision were discussed

Parents Oct.-Nov. 2024

During ISP and parent-teacher meetings, parents of At-Risk Students were informed of results and student learning plans were based on Fall SLAs screenings and classroom assessment results.

Staff Sept. 2024

The First 90-Day Goals were created with staff. These included ways to provide FRIM reading intervention, to better train EAs in reading support, to continue to provide ONE thing feedback.

Parents Nov/Dec 2024

AB Assurance and achievement results will be shared at the School Council meeting. This includes the school's progress towards our 100% Vision and 90-Day Improvement Plan.

Staff Sept. 2024

Leadership Team - set up school timetabling to include time for both English and French small group intervention teachers.
